Opportunity High School is a partnership school between Hartford Public Schools and Our Piece of the Pie, Inc. (OPP). It is a high school that offers curriculum to over-age and under-credited young people who have, or are in danger of, dropping out of traditional high school settings. Opportunity High School combines OPP's proven youth and workforce development practices and Hartford Public Schools' rigorous education practices to re-engage students and help them achieve a high school diploma.
